<p>Who is your hero? Draw a picture of them and write about why they are a hero. <b>20 points</b></p>	<p>Find a piece of news that shows someone doing a heroic act <b>15 points</b></p>	<p>If you could have a superpower what would it be? Design a super hero costume and label it. <b>20 points</b></p>	<p>Design a poster featuring a new super hero that conveys an important message. <b>25 points</b></p>
<p>Make a table and compare the characteristics of a villain and a hero <b>20 Points</b></p>	<p>Help out at home and take a picture of yourself being a super kid <b>25 Points</b></p>	<p>Can you crack the superhero code. Ask your teacher for the code and see if you can crack it to read the message. <b>30 Points</b></p>	<p>Research a real life hero and write a fact file all about them and why they are a hero. <b>35 Points</b></p>
