## Coronavirus: Potential School Closure Letter to Parents Re: Potential School Closure due to the spread of Coronavirus

Dear Parents/Carers

I'm sure you are aware of the outbreak of Coronavirus (COVID-19) and the increase in the number of confirmed cases in the UK.

We take the Health and Safety of our pupils and staff very seriously and, while there is currently no cause for concern at our school, we will keep you updated with any developments, including whether we will need to close.

Current guidance from the Department for Education (DfE) and Public Health England (PHE) remains that schools stay open; however, it is possible that this advice may change as the spread of Coronavirus continues. If we are required to close our school, we will take the necessary steps to ensure you are informed of the closure and that the effect on pupils' education is limited.

In the event that we do close the school, you will be informed via: **Text Message System, School Website, Learning Platform,** and advised on how long we expect the closure to last. Please check that you have provided us with your most up-to-date contact details to ensure you receive any correspondence regarding a closure. If you need to provide us with new details, please contact the school office on **(01332) 346230.**
