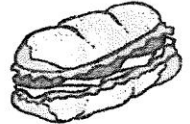


The Greedy Boy

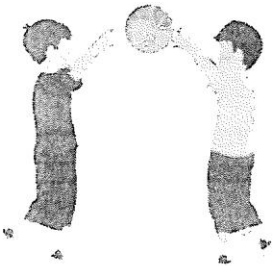
