Metaphor:
 A metaphor compares two things that are the same. They use "is, was, were or are".

- Example: *The sun is an eye, looking over the fields.*

Simile:
 A simile compares two things that are similar. They use "like or as".

- Example: *The skin felt as hot as fire.*
