


# Design a VE Day Medal

This medal celebrated the end of the First World War and was given to soldiers who had fought in active theatres of the war. It was a symbol of **great pride** but its design was also highly **symbolic**.



Bronze medal, not too expensive after the war, but long lasting.



## Task:

Design a medal for British soldiers who served in the Second World War that is symbolic and creative. Think about your choices for the medal and ribbon.

You should include:

- The years of the war (1939-1945)
- The colours of the Allies (red, white & blue)
- A symbol to signify the war and the soldier's sacrifice and victory
- A reference to the many theatres of fighting (Europe, Africa, Asia, Air, Sea, Land)
- Annotations to explain your choices
