Here is a square.



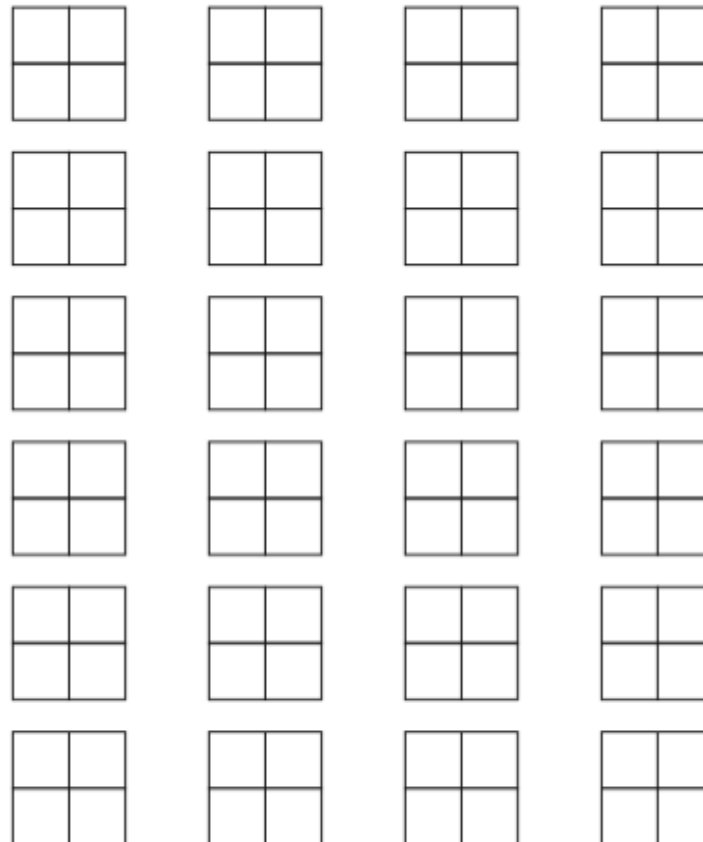
Here are 2 halves and 4 quarters of the square.
