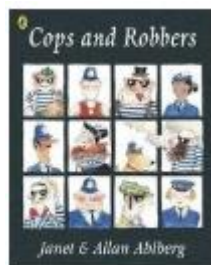

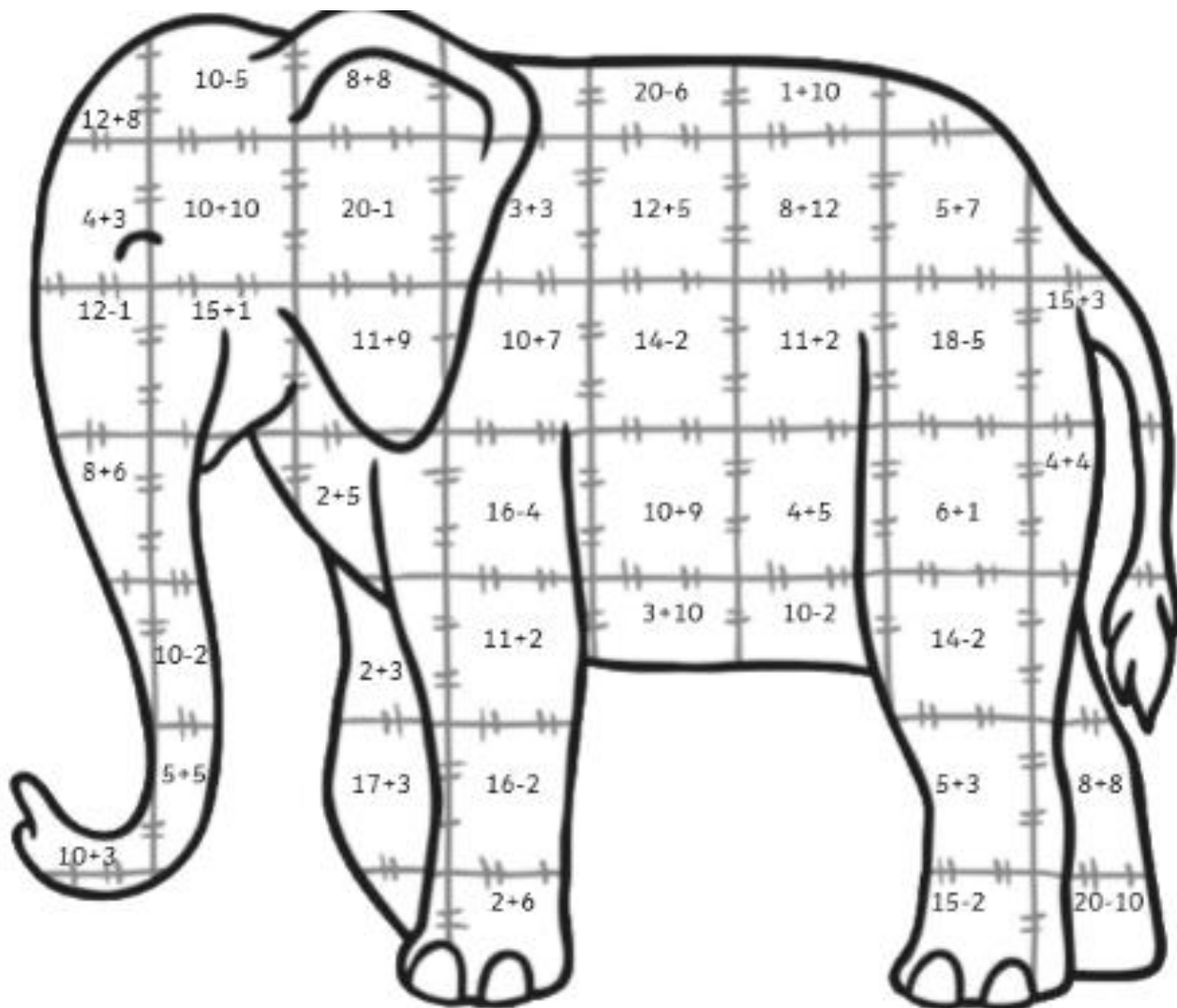
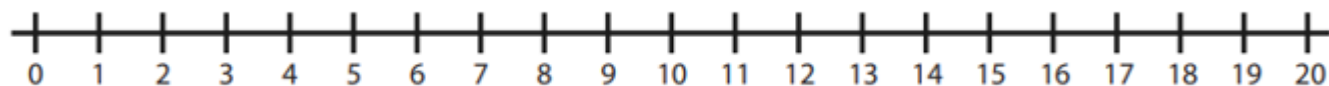
Making structures stronger.

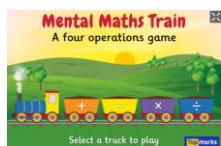
Using building blocks, Lego or recycled materials at home have a go at using some of the techniques from the video.
