What is direct speech?

Direct speech is a sentence in which the exact words spoken are reproduced in **speech** marks (also known as quotation marks or inverted commas). For example: "You'll never guess what I've just seen!" said Sam, excitedly.


Speech rules:

Only the words spoken by the character goes inside the inverted commas.

New speaker needs a new line.

Punctuation goes inside the inverted commas.

A great way to remember how to punctuate direct speech is ...



Say "open, speech, punctuation, close, reporting clause (who and how)"
