















Reasoning and Problem solving



Fasting


Fasting in the month of Ramadan is the fourth of the five pillars of Islam.

The five pillars of Islam are the five things you must remember to be a good Muslim.



Eid al-Fitr

- Eid al-Fitr is the festival at the end of Ramadan.
- It celebrates the end of fasting.
- In some countries, Eid celebrations may only last for one day. In other countries, Eid may be celebrated for up to three days.
- Friends and family gather together to pray and share meals and gifts.
- Food is also given to the poor. This is called 'Zakat', which is the third pillar of Islam.
