Practise reading these words:

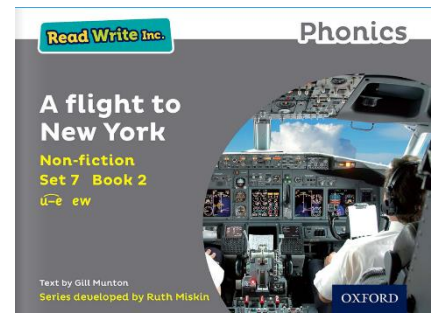
drive huge park air crew seat belt meal stew

### definition

<b>air crew</b>	people who see to your needs on an aircraft
<b>check in</b>	hand in your bags
<b>passport</b>	a small book with your name and photograph inside that shows which country you come from
<b>screened</b>	checked to make sure that you are not carrying anything dangerous
<b>X-ray</b>	a photograph which shows the inside of something
<b>life jackets</b>	blow-up jackets for a landing on water
<b>cockpit</b>	the part of the aircraft where the pilot sits
<b>co-pilot</b>	the assistant pilot
