	Generic newspaper report	My newspaper report
Headline	What is the news story about? Short and catchy to grab the reader's attention- it might include a pun or alliteration.	
Paragraph 1 (Introduction)	Describe the story on the whole and grab the reader's interest. Include: 5ws- who? What? When? Why? Where?	
Paragraph 2/3	Provide background information, provide a context, add more detail	
Paragraph 4	Quotes from key characters/ eye witnesses.	
Conclusion	What is happening now? What might happen next?
