





You are going to be writing a newspaper report linked to Oliver Twist from when he has left the workhouse.

Using your boxing up plan, have a go at writing the headline and Introduction of the newspaper report. Use the model newspaper report (Strange Objects Appear in Classroom) to help you.

Remember the introduction should answer the 5ws!

## Who?

Description of character (personality and appearance)

## When?

Description of exact times, dates or years (possibly even generic timings such as 'one morning.')

## What?

Details of what the piece is based upon- introducing a dramatic event or reporting on an event that has already happened.

## Where?

Description of the setting, usually includes the 5 senses- the more descriptive, the more it draws in the reader (creates images in the mind).

## Why?

Why the events happened. These are often evidence or fact based genres such as persuasive writing or report writing.
