Task

Moral dilemma 1

A new girl arrives in your class. She has come from another country and doesn't know anyone. Some of your friends say that you should not try to make friends with her. They say there is no room for new people in your group of friends.

What should you do?

Moral dilemma 2

You are walking across the school playground at the end of break time when you notice a toy on the floor. It is a toy that you have always really wanted. Your friend says you should put it in your bag and take it home. No one else is looking.

What should you do?

Moral dilemma 3

You are playing in a football match and the score is 1:1. In the final minute your teammate crosses the ball to you. You are not confident at heading the ball but you can reach it with your hand and punch it into the goal. The referee is looking the other way.

What should you do?

Moral dilemma 4

You really want the new album by your favourite pop group but you don't have enough money to buy it. A friend says he knows a website where you can download it for free. He says it's not the same as stealing.

What should you do?

After reading the dilemmas, think about what you would do in that situation. Why would you do that? Now think about what a humanist would do. Are they different?

Remember the reasons humanists believe we should be good:

- We should treat others the way we would like to be treated
- If everyone tries to do the right thing, we can make the world a better place; if everyone does the wrong thing, then everyone will be worse off
- Making other people happy can make us happy
