

# Introductory Activity



### Nouns

**Nouns** are often known as 'naming words' because they can name people, places and things.






### Simple noun phrases

Simple noun phrases are groups of words, including a noun, that make up part of a sentence.

The noun is the main word in the phrase and other words give information about it.





### Expanded noun phrases

Expanded noun phrases give more detail than a simple noun phrase.

The tall, sporty girl

the determiner adjective noun



### Simple noun phrases

You add adjectives after the determiner to make an expanded noun phrase

This adds extra detail about the noun.


**Determiner**s are placed before the noun and help to describe it.

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

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## Adjectives for Effect



The adjectives we choose to expand the noun phrase can create very different effects.

Example – the house





We could see a **bright**, **airy** <u>house</u>.

We could see a dark, gloomy house.

The evil creature that howled all night was never allowed outside.





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# Consolidation Activity



### Consequence Game



- Work in pairs using plain A4 paper.
- The first player draws the head of a monster and passes it unseen (by means of folding) to the second player.
