mi primo – my cousin (m)

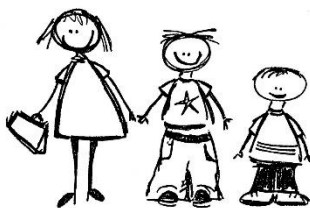
mi prima – my cousin (f)
