“How are you feeling about Oliver not coming home?”

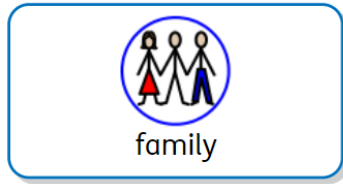
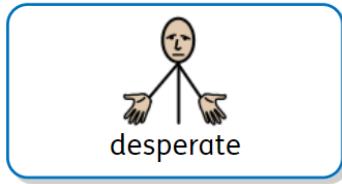
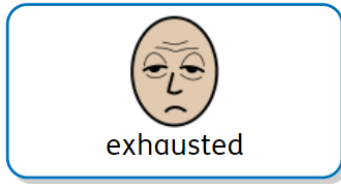
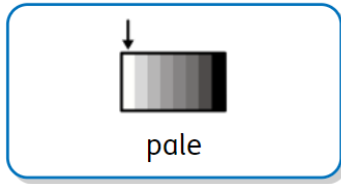
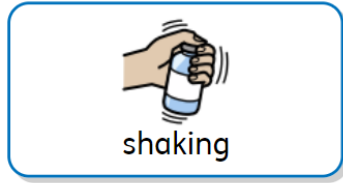
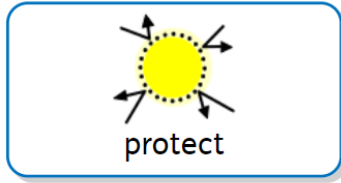
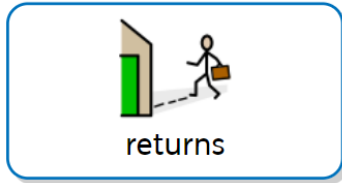
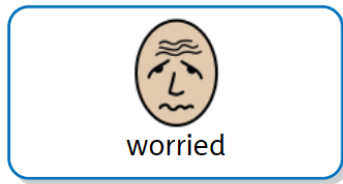
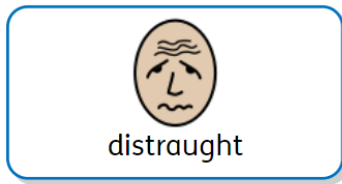
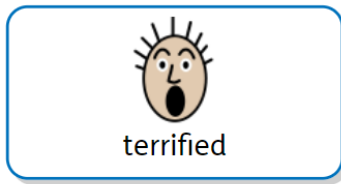
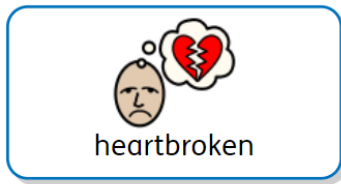
