Today you are writing paragraph 3- the problem.

In this paragraph you need to write about how the monster is very difficult to defeat and how the hero struggles to defeat it.

Things to think about:

- What did you write about in paragraph 2?
- What is the monster doing that is really bad? How is it terrorising the town/village that the hero lives in?
- What is the hero planning to do in order to defeat it?
- **Remember** that in this paragraph the hero does not defeat the monster! Maybe he/she is planning on going to the place where the monster lives to try and defeat it. Maybe something gets in the way or makes it difficult.

When you have finished writing your paragraph, read back through it and check that it makes sense, check that you have included full stops and capital letters and that you have lots of good quality vocabulary included- keep looking at the writer's toolkit!
