Recently, he got kicked out of the orphanage for asking more gruel as it wasn't sufficient enough for him so he made a run

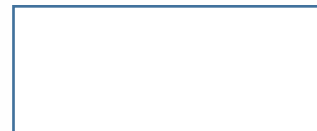
for London, although we can't be precise, it much have taken up to 7 days. We suspect that he is around 9 years old and has no guardians to take care of him.
