Read the parable and the bible story on the next pages. Think about what they tell us about Christian beliefs.

Christians believe that people can do good things, but our bad choices spoil us in some ways. They believe that God and Jesus can save us from this. For Christians, trusting God, as seen in Jesus may matter even more than being good because it helps a person to be good.

Jesus often compared actions to fruits. The roots are down inside us, hidden thoughts and intentions, but what you do shows what you value.

Your task is to create an image of a tree. You could use the picture I have provided, or create your own. Be as imaginative and creative as you can!

- On the leaves or the fruit write words to represent good actions. For example: using kind words
- On the branches, trunk and roots write things that lead to these good actions. For example: thinking about how others feel
