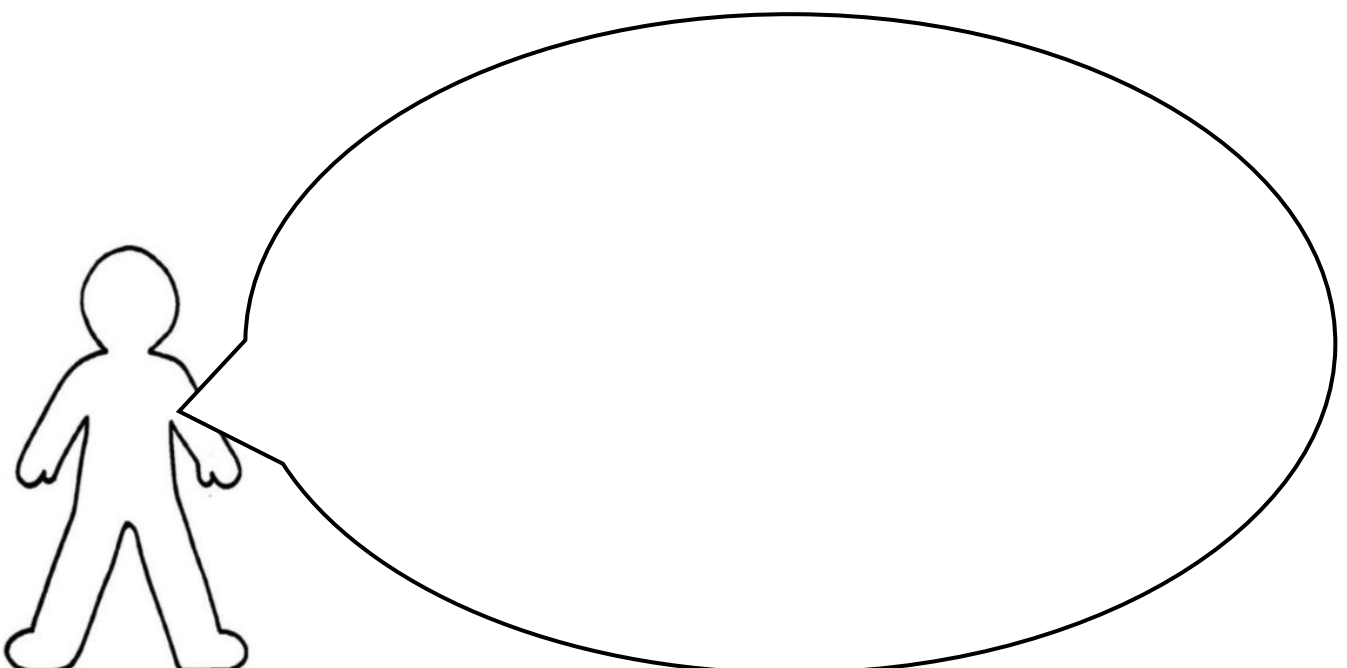
What questions have you got about what happens when we die?
